We will be holding a live virtual parent workshop focussing on Phonics and Reading next half term. We will send you a live link closer to the time so you can access this. Following the workshop we will send you a short survey to gather your feedback and we would appreciate it if you could complete and submit this.

- Homework is given on a **Friday** and must be handed in the following week either in person or on Tapestry.
