IMPORTANT: Please do NOT share your login details or password.

When joining the lesson...

Please ensure you are working at a desk or table.



Be on time and wait for the teacher to let you in.



Have all your equipment ready including pencil and paper.



Make sure you are on mute. Only unmute if you are asked to.



When taking part in the lesson...

Behave as you would in the school classroom and listen carefully at all times.



Complete tasks along with the teacher to support your learning.



You should have your cameras on for all live lessons.



Do not film or screenshot any part of the lesson.



During the lesson you can use the chat to answer the teachers questions or to leave a comment.

The chat is only to be used when lessons are on.

At the end of the lesson listen out for any tasks you need to complete before the next lesson. It is important to follow all of our rules so we can keep you safe and you can take part in all of your live lessons.
