

Curriculum Overview | Guru Nanak Sikh Academy

Year 6 | Spring 1 | 2020-2021



Literacy

In English this term we will be reading 'Goodnight Mister Tom' and our writing focus will be character descriptions and informal letters. As part of language and grammar development pupils will be expected to use a range of punctuation and sentence structures and continue to use the Year 6 grammar criteria.

Maths

This term pupils will be learning about **geometry, algebra, measurement, ratio, and proportion**. We will continue to focus on reasoning and solving problems in real life context. Furthermore, we will recap all previously taught areas in preparation for SATS.

Humanities

This term pupils will be learning about 'Education through time' Children will learn about the initial introduction of education and the main developments over time with a particular emphasis on the Victorian times (thinking about the lifestyles of children from different classes and their options in this period).

Science

This half term in Science pupils will learn about Animals including Humans. Children will learn about the circulatory system and how to maintain a healthy lifestyle.

Art

This term pupils will be looking at Famous Fashions through History. We will explore how design was used in homes, clothes, accessories and explain our opinions on use of line, tone, colour, shape, form, texture, pattern, structure, contrast and mood.

Music

This term pupils will be taught various musical skills through online lessons.

Punjabi and Sikh Studies

This term pupils will focus on the role of the elderly in their lives. Furthermore, the pupils will be looking at our lifestyle; healthy and unhealthy choices. In Sikhism pupils will learn about Guru Gobind Singh Ji.

Computing

This term pupils will be focusing on the topic '**We are Network Technicians**'. They will learn about computer networks, E-safety and about the World Wide Web as a communication tool. They will then investigate different methods of communication.

PSHE

This term the pupils will be learning about how to keep personal information safe, regulations and choices. They will learn how to report the misuse of personal information or sharing of upsetting content/ images online. Pupils will also learn about the risks and effects of different drugs. Including the laws relating to drugs common to everyday life and illegal drugs

P.E

Creative unit -This term pupils will be looking at static balance. They will learn to adapt and adjust skills, movements or tactics. They will also use core muscles to try and stay in balance as much as possible

Literacy

Art

Science

This term pupils will be learning about Living things and their habitats. They will explore different ways to classify animals, design their own animal to classify and explore different microorganisms. They will look at different scientists' ideas about classifying and decide whether they support or refute their ideas.

Computing

This term in computing the topic is '**We are data collectors**'. Pupils will learn about Google sheets and will be organising data. They will be taught the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and will begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data. They will learn to apply formulas that include a range of cells, and apply formulas to multiple cells by duplicating them.

PSHE

This term pupils will be learning about safe relationships. They will be recognising and managing pressure; consent in different situations

Social unit - We will be looking at dynamic balance and counter balancing through different positioning of our body.
